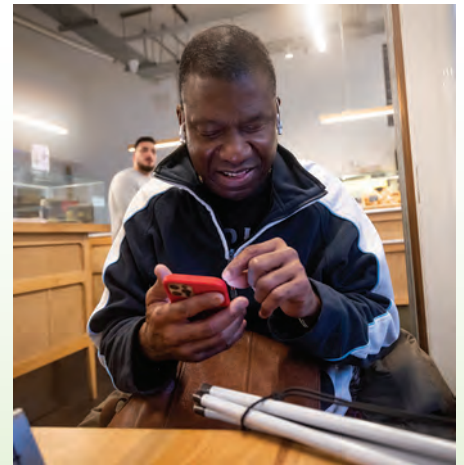

The following questions will help you in deciding whether or not the service provider that you are calling will be able to fully meet your needs as an older adult.

- What services do they provide?
- What age group do they service?
- What special services are there for older adults?
- How do they accept referrals?
- Who is the contact person?
- What are the costs? Are there additional costs? (taxes, service fees, etc.)
- What are the rules for eligibility?
- When are they open? (hours and/or days of operation, etc.)
- How do you get there? (transportation)
- Are there any brochures about the resources?
- What geographical area do they serve?
- Is there a waiting list?
- Is there any other information that is important?

Suggestions for Calling

- Take notes to remember the details.
- Be careful how much personal information you share (e.g. SIN, Health Card Number).

Ask for the name of the person who has helped you.
